

8 Fire goeth forth before him, and burneth up his enemies round about.

PSALM XCVIII.

Psalmist called to praise God

1 SING unto the LORD a new song: for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand and his holy arm, have got him the victory.

2 The LORD hath made known his salvation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen.

3 He hath remembered his mercy and his truth towards the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.

4 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye that love him: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.

5 Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm.

6 With trumpets and sound of cornet make a joyful noise before the LORD the King.

7 Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof, the world, and they that dwell therein.

8 Let the floods clap their hands: let the hills be joyful together.

9 Before the LORD; *for he cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall he judge the world, and the people with equity.

PSALM XCIX.

The Prophet calleth for the King of God in Zion.

1 LORD, thy strength let the people tremble: *he saith between the cherubims; let the earth tremble and move.

2 The LORD is great in Zion; and he is 'high above all people.

3 Let them praise thy great and terrible name; for it is holy.

4 'The king's strength also loveth judgment; thou dost establish equity, thou executest judgment and righteousness as Jacob.

5 Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his holy footstool; for he is holy.

6 Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among them that call upon his name; they called upon the LORD, and he answered them.

7 He spake unto them in the cloudy pillar: they kept his testimonies, and the ordinance that he gave them.

PSALM CI.

David maketh a vow and profession of godliness.

A Psalm of David.

1 WILL sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.

2 I will behave myself wisely in a perfect way. When wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a perfect heart.

3 I will say no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside: I shall not cleave to me.

4 A froward heart shall depart from me: I will not know a wicked person.

5 Who so privately slandereth his neighbour, his will I cut off: and whoso hateth a high look and a proud heart, will I remove.

6 Mine eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a perfect way, he shall serve me.

7 He that doeth deceit shall not dwell in my house: he that telleth lies shall not stand in my sight.

8 I will early declare and the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD.

PSALM CII.

The mercies of God are to be recorded.

1 A prayer of the afflicted, when he is overwhelmed, and poureth out his complaint before the LORD.

2 HARK my prayer, O LORD, and let mine cry come unto thee.

3 Incline thine ear unto my voice; when I call, answer me speedily.

4 For my days are consumed like smoke, and my bones are dried as an hearth.

5 My heart is smitten, and withered like grass; so that I forget to eat my bread.

6 By reason of the voice of my groaning, my bones cleave to my skin.

7 I am like a palm tree in the desert: I am like an owl of the desert.

8 I have been as a stranger in the land, as a sojourner, as a pilgrim, as a wanderer.

9 Mine enemies reproach me all the day; and they that are mad against me are sworn against me.

10 For I have eaten ashes like bread, and mingled my drink with weeping,

11 Because of thine indignation and thy wrath; for thou hast lifted me up, and cast me down.
